Selection procedure	Complete applications are handed over to the head of the relevant study programme leader and the teachers concerned, who in turn examine the applications in detail. Applicants will be selected on the basis of the quality of their application, their artistic level and human resources. All applicants will be informed about the selection result within 4-6 weeks after application.

Language of instruction	Language Requirements:
	 English: A strong command of English at a B2 level is required for all students participating in the program. German: While basic knowledge of German is recommended, it is not mandatory for participating in the mobility program.
